

## NOMINATION COMMITTEE REPORT

*To our Members:*

At our AGM on June 11th, we received a few questions relating to the Nomination Committee. We'd like to provide more information to help clear up any confusion and bring you an update.

Currently, there are two trustees stepping down this fall: Jason Waldner, who will have served 3 years and Ron Meisner, who will have served 6 years. (Ron has offered to make himself available one more year if the need is required). One of the current trustees, Dino Silvestri, has indicated he is willing to let his name stand for another term and will be one of the nominees voted on for renewal. Therefore, we'll be looking for several people (room for 8 more) to fill the positions of trustees as the planning calendar gets busy again in the fall.

The Elders, who lead the Nomination process according to the by-laws, have identified approximately 48 familiar GMBC members who would be approached to consider willingness to serve in leadership roles, such as trustees, elders, the LMI and LCS Boards. Additionally, the NC has solicited nomination input from the membership general and so far has not received any new nominees. The Nomination Committee will be contacting potential nominees in the coming weeks to ask for them to consider participating in leadership at Grant. As was mentioned at the AGM, we did not have any names to bring forward this June. The leadership team is working through putting in place a leadership orientation strategy that would be broader than what we have seen traditionally and provide an opportunity to engage membership (and those considering membership) to help provide more visibility to what is encompassed in those roles to help equip potential nominees.

We're sorry for any confusion the lack of nominees or updates may have caused. We recognize the importance of keeping our membership updated on the status of nominations and Trustee members and trust that this update helps inform you of the plan stepping forward. Please continue to pray with us regarding those that are and will be involved in helping to provide leadership within the Grant Community.
